# Altar Guild Checklist

## Paraments/Banners

- 1. Check calendar for color (calendar is in cabinet)
- 2. Have banners match calendar color

## Altar Table

- 1. Candles & Christ Candle (Fill with oil 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday)
- 2. Flowers (place flowers on the table)

## Lord's Supper (Communion Sunday)

- 1. Communion on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday & special Sundays (see calendar)
- 2. Wine & Grape Juice
  - b. Fill all four trays
  - c. Grape juice in the center ring & Wine in the rest
  - d. Goblet with 3" of wine
- 3. Wafers
- 4. Basket lined with napkins (to collect empty cups)
- 5. Clean up of Lord's Supper
  - a. Between services (remove empty trays and empty out the basket)
  - b. After service
    - i. Return unused wafers to container
    - ii. Dispose unused wine and juice into the ground
    - iii. Wash all trays, plate, lid, goblet with hot soapy water
    - iv. Dry all pieces thoroughly and place in appropriate cloth covers

## Baptism

- 1. Fill baptismal pitcher with warm water and place on altar (before the baptismal service)
- 2. Empty water afterward
- 3. Place candle & certificate on the altar table (see Patti's desk)

## Final Clean Up (after the second service)

- 1. Take out flowers and place in fellowship hall
- 2. Take pastor's sermon and lector notes and place under pastor's door
- 3. Keep an eye on the supplies inform the Altar Guild Chairman when low
